October Meeting Round-up

For this month's meeting of Ring 96 we welcomed back Jheff our lecturer from last month. He was our emcee for our annual "Night of Weird Magic and Mentalism."

Jheff opened the meeting with a free choice of a pair of envelopes and the goal was to find the coin in one of them. The spectator chose envelope number one. He failed to find the coin, but did find a note that said "I knew you would pick envelope number one.

Jeff continued by flipping a coin that was red on one side and black on the other. The

audience was asked to stand up and predict each flip. We were to sit down if we got it wrong.

After four flips all but one person was sitting down. A prediction described everything he was wearing down to the design on his t-shirt.

Jon Strum came up to perform. He lit three candles, and called for three volunteers. He gave each volunteer a good luck charm or a "mojo." He had the volunteers roll one die each and choose a number. Then he dealt out tarot cards to the volunteers. He told them to move one card from the top to the bottom of their small pack. The number should match the die roll. The first volunteer now turned over

the card of "death" and was asked to sit down. The other two chose different cards, In fact they found the only two cards in the deck that were not "death."

Jheff had a prediction. He had hands drawn on a blank clock. The hands matched the prediction.

Ten-year-old future Ring 96 member Max had a card selected. The card somehow was found reversed in the deck between the two jokers.

Kevin had a car selected. Then he brought out a billfold with a paper ghost in it. He pulled out the ghost and set it on fire. It vanished in a "poof." But the ghost reappeared in the deck, stuck to the chosen card.

When the ghost was removed from the card, it had reappeared in the billfold.

Mage (Roger) gave us an explanation on his being a time traveler. He spoke of needing to align people to the right frequency. He produced a board with a grid of 16 playing cards in a 4 x 4 set up. He had everyone think of one and then move in certain ways until every one mysteriously landed on the same card.

Jheff had a volunteer pick items from a bag... a famous person, an animal and a fruit. Chosen were Albert Einstein, and Giraffe and a banana. A previous prediction was shown to have the three chosen items.

John Piercy came out dressed in a lab coast with a wig as Dr. Ripuoff. He had a black and white drawing of a haunted house. When he pulled the house out of the frame, it became all colored in.

Jheff showed us a poster he had ordered of the movie the avengers. The poster came in eight pieces. He used invisible tape to restore the poster to a single piece.

New member Vinnie Marini performed three quick card tricks including having a card signed, lost and found. He had the card put in the deck and into a card box.

He had the box rubber banded shut. When he hit the deck on the table, the selected signed card flew out. He ended with an irreverent bit where a cork lying on its side is covered with a cup, The cork is shown to have stood up under the cup.

David Yuhas had a pair of dice in his hand. They were different colors. The numbers on the dice seemed to amazingly change at his command.

Jheff ended the night with five large envelopes and five volunteers. They were allowed to arrange themselves as they wished. When the opened up the envelopes, each had a different solid colored piece of paper and then we saw a prediction envelope. The prediction told us what order they would be standing in.

Kevin showed of his new take on the ring on the rope trick. He combined a coin trick, a vanish and transposition with the tried and true effect.


