July Meeting Round-up

On Saturday July 15th Ring 96 held its most recent meeting. We started with a pre-meeting workshop focusing on Oil & Water for the second month.

Workshop participants were asked to practice what they learned from part one, and then show off at part two.

The meeting proper began with HUBB taking the podium. HUBB is known as an outstanding close-up performer who specializes

in bar magic.

He opened with by putting a scrambled Rubik's Cube into a paper bag. A moment later he reached into the bag and pulled out the cube completely solved and intact. The way he was holding the bag made it clear there was something else in there, and we all figured it was the unsolved cube. No, it was a clear plastic drinking glass full of water which he openly drank.

Next, he held up a plastic card holder that contained

index cards labeled 1
through 6. A volunteer
chose one, the other side
read "Free beer." But the
rest of the cards all read
"new car." On stage, he
would have genuinely given
a beer to the volunteer.


A volunteer picked a card from a deck that featured Rubik's cubes in various states of scramble. A cube sitting on the table proved to match the card, then the cube was held into the volunteer's hand and disintegrated into a handful of skittles candy.

to solve a Rubik's Cube in four moves without looking gimmicked.

A volunteer was presented with a deck of cards and randomly chose the six of diamonds. HUBB said he would find the card in ten seconds. We all counted down as he looked through the deck. The card was actually under HUBB's drinking glass. HUBB worked this gag in several times, continuously finding the six under the glass.

He introduced a custom designed "Drink Card." Every time that card comes up, everyone must drink. This card then seemed to get chosen every time as HUBB performed his version of the ambitious card.

HUBB taught us his favorite card force and how to use it. It is very clever, but will take some practice to get right.

He showed us his technique for using the memorized deck. Using this allowed him to pull a randomly named card out of the middle of the deck.

We continued to find the "drink card" instead of the chosen card as HUBB kept the routine moving. A volunteer wrote their name on a chosen card, when it was lost in the deck, the "drink card" came up.

HUBB ended his lecture by teaching us some card misdirection. He taught us how to palm a pen, and a few other sleight of hand moves.

This made for another exciting night at Ring 96!

Stage Competition

So far we have 8 out of 10 members signed up to perform in this year's stage competition. There is room for two more to perform. Perhaps one will be you? Remember the special steps to take before you sign up...

- Practice your routine many multiple times.
- Practice your routine for a mirror or on video so you can see what the audience will see.
- 3) Practice your routine in front of someone!

- Get honest feedback and adjust your routine as needed.
- 5) Time your routine. Don't forget to include time for audience reaction, picking volunteers and volunteers approaching the stage.
- 6) Invite all your friends to come watch the competition. Heck, invite your enemies too! Other magicians will be glad for the votes.
- 7) Block your props! That is have your magical equipment set up in proper order to be easily

- moved on and off the stage, as well as easy to reach during your set.
- 8) Stick to the set list you signed up with. Changing your set-list at the last minute might not be fair or appropriate to another performer. Having two members perform the same trick does not make for a professional show either.

To sign up, E-mail Cliff at cliffg37@proton.me by August 19th and hand in your set-list, then you will be ready to go.

Their hours are still limited. Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday 12-5, but at least they are open.


They are still operating on a cash basis. That is, no credit or debit cards. Cash only.





Mark Cannon's Lecture



Mark Cannon will be presenting a lecture for us that is partially a book report, and partially his Magic Castle Escape act. For the book report, he will be speaking on this historical book about this amazing man, Horatio Cooke. For his escape act, Mark will be present some escapes that he has performed at the Magic Castle. This lecture will prove to be a bit different than most, but still should prove to be exciting and highly educational.

This is in fact the INCREDIBLE TRUE STORY of the brave and resourceful young captain of the Civil War's super-secret LINCOLN SPECIAL SCOUTS, Harry Green Cooke.

Based upon the personal diary and scrapbook of Harry Cooke, as well as additional recently discovered information, this is the first time that this amazing story has been printed into a book—finally fulfilling the promise the author made to Cooke's daughter in 1981.

- Herein is the full account of Cooke's exploits as the captain of the Lincoln Special Scouts—the elite secret scout and spy entity formed two years before the US Secret Service and assigned the most dangerous missions of all during the Civil War...

Mark R. Cannon is a husband and father of two. Professionally, he has been a cruise ship magician, and an escape artist consultant for numerous television programs, and for many of the famous magicians of the world. He served as an airborne law enforcement sergeant-pilot for 36 years. An avid adventurer, he has travelled to over 70 countries including all seven continents. His interests include back-country flying, baseball, magic, the Great Outdoors, and American History. He is the recipient of the 2006 Leslie P. Guest M-U-M Award of Excellence, presented by the Society of American Magician's for his literary work on "Harry Cooke, American Wizard"


