September Meeting Round-up

On Saturday September 17th Jheff came to lecture for Ring 96. Jheff opened his lecture by presenting a magnetic white board with nine postcards on it. Each card was a nice graphic piece of artwork that represented a fictional place from literature. He asked everyone to use their phones to zoom in to the board and place their finger on one of the four corner cards. He gave us instructions to move our fingers up or down, left or

right, but not diagonally as he had us move a chosen number of cards. After each move, he eliminated two of the cards. When three were left, he turned the board around and showed his selected prediction. We all matched and gave him his applause.

Jheff invited a volunteer to the table and handed him about half the deck of cards. He had the volunteer look though the deck and selected a card by free choice. Our jaws dropped as we realized that Jheff was (believe it or not) doing the 21-card trick. However, the

effect worked much better as Jheff worked ESP into the routine and turned it from a lame elementary school trick into a beautiful piece of magical art.

Jheff discussed the importance of connecting with the audience and the volunteers, how to reveal a card the right way, building suspense, and anticipation, and how to control volunteers and the audience.

We got a good strong explanation to the principal that Jheff's latest book is based on. It turns out to be all but self-working and can even be disguised in

different ways.

Jheff had a volunteer take a special five card deck of cards. Each card had an Icon on it for an aspect of things a person might want of aspire to. The cards were mixed and laid out face down. Three coins (Quarter. nickel and penny) were placed out and the volunteer was told to take a coin. He used the quarter to place on a random downfaced card and move the coin a selected number of times. Jheff had two predictions. One suggested that the quarter would be used and the other stated which card it would land on.

The next effect we meet Jheff the High School teacher who takes his kids on a field trip to a museum. One hides in an exhibit room. A board is shown with nine exhibit rooms labeled on it. Which room did the volunteer want to hide in? He picked one. How long did the volunteer want to hide for? He picked 12 minutes. Jheff started in one room and had the volunteer count 12 rooms. He landed on the chosen room.

Jheff ended with a real shocker. He had a volunteer pull out nine of the twelve court cards in a deck at random and arrange them in a three-by-three grid. He was told to place his finger on one of the corner court cards. Jheff had a set of custom-made cards in his hand that he read off. Each one either told the volunteer to move a number of places around the grid, or suggested which card in which position should be removed. At the end, the volunteer had his finger in the upper right corner, while all the other cards were gone. In a shock and surprise ending, Jheff showed one last card that proclaimed the card was the Queen of Diamonds. We had all learned the principle, and that was fine, but how Jheff could predict not only which cards the volunteer would choose, but which one would be in that position was a headscratcher.

Jheff ended his amazing lecture by revealing how that effect could be done and he surely won the admiration of the entire Ring.

It was an exciting night at Hof's Hut. Will you be there next month?




