October Meeting Round-up

The October meeting of Ring 96 started off with a double bonus surprise. First, we had master card magician Jeremy Griffith come to lead our premeeting workshop. The members had been instructed to bring their own deck and Jeremy taught 12 of our members some of his incredible sleights. how to table shuffle while maintaining a 'brief' to mark a spot in order to do false shuffles and control cards. He gave some background about how this type of thing has

evolved and credited different magicians for different aspects of the moves He was extremely knowledgeable.

Next, we opened our meeting proper and introduced our guest emcee for the night Jheff. Jheff is a Magic Castle performer, the publisher of a newsletter for mentalists and the originator of several mentalism effects. He proved to be the perfect host for our night of "weird magic and mentalism."

Jheff opened the show with what appeared to be a sight-gag. He covered his hand with a silk, and asked a volunteer to pick a number

from 1 to 5. The number 3 was chosen and Jheff removed the silk to show three fingers. He took out on card from his pocket, and asked for the suit. Hearts was called out. The card in his hand was the 3 of hearts.

Joyce Basch took the stage dressed as the queen of hearts. She had a set of 8 ½ by 11-inch envelopes labeled 1-9. She had the audience decide how to mix the cards and what order they should be in. She called for 9 volunteers and gave each one a card. When the envelopes were opened the volunteers were each holding a letter, and in the



correct order spelled "Halloween."

Kim Hallinger was next and poured some hideous ingredients into a pan, including, pepper, cayenne pepper, and old sock, and more. She covered the pan, and son revealed it was full of peppermint candies.

Jheff came out with four different colored envelopes. He asked the first volunteer to pick one, he chose Green and was given that one to hold. The next volunteer chose blue and got that envelope. The third person picked red, and was given that envelope. That left Yellow which Jheff handed to a last volunteer. They opened the envelopes. The green one had a note which read "You will pick the green envelope." Very funny. The Blue and Red envelopes had similar comedic messages matching their color. The yellow one; the last one left stated the correct order of which the envelopes would be picked.

David Fisher brought out a bag and the story of Frank

McGillicuddy. Frank could cut to any named card in the deck and David demonstrated this. He changed four aces to four sevens and also changed the colors of the backs of the deck from red to blue.

President John Piercy brought out a square cage with a circular tube inside it. He showed both to be empty. He told a story of visiting a haunted house. First he pulled out spider webs from the empty tube. He demonstrated them empty again and pulled out a ghost. Once again, he pulled out the tube and it was still empty, but when he put it back in, out came bats. Finally, he pulled out a gnome.

Jheff returned to the stage with a rolled-up silk. He made a pair of knots in the silk and then vanished the knots, and unrolled the silk revealing a picture of a ghost. There were two holes in the silk where the knots had been and where the ghost's eye would have been.

Kevin Papke performed the Zoltan trick. A card was chosen, and Kevin read notes off the box that helped to describe the card and how it was picked. The chosen card was soon found sticking out of Kevin's pocket.

Paul Case came to the stage and did a few jokes and sight-gags before bring out a book of "travel destinations." He had a volunteer pick a destination and easily guessed it correctly. Paul followed that with a set of ESP cards that were placed in a rack at random order, but matched his prediction.

Jheff had a volunteer pick a page and a word from a book. Letter by letter he figured out the word and had it written on a previously unshown pad.

Joseph Ken was our next performer. He brought up a volunteer and showed him the Ace of Spades that he called the card of death. Joe shuffled the Ace into the deck. He guided the volunteer into crisscrossing the deck to pick a card. The chosen card was the Queen of Diamonds.

Oddly the card right next to the queen was the Ace of Spades. On the back was written "it is not your time." A very creepy ending to a fine effect.

Bill Pearce brought up a spatula which he proceeded to psychically bend and then restore back to its original shape. Then he told an elaborate story about he and his wife picking out a casket for him to use after he passed. The picture of the casket was ornate and very expensive. Bill kept folding the paper, shrinking the accoutrements and lowering the price till all that was left was a trash can.

Jheff brought up two volunteers and gave them each a set of ten Uno cards. He performed a "cards across" routine with them.

His closing effect called for six volunteers. Jheff read instructions from a series of cards calling for the volunteers to take different actions and sending them back to their seats. The winner was asked to pick a number from 1 – 25. Jheff

read from the list of prizes.
The prizes were awkward,
unusual and disgusting.

However, the one picked (number 5) called for a stuffed animal. This had been in a bag in plain sight the whole time.

Music, costumes and volunteers are encouraged if appropriate.


Bring friends to watch if you can.


