April Meeting Round-up

David Gray Mini-Lecture Series on April 20, 2019

The Seal Beach Magic Club/ IBM Ring 96 held it's 3rd David Gray Mini-Series. There were five wellaccomplished lecturers who covered a wide range of magical topics. The lecturers were David Fisher, Marty Gorman, Chris Fleming, Bill Pearce, and Phil Ureno.

David Fisher started the lectures off with his subject of "The Use Of Envelopes in Magic and Mentalism". David referenced the use of envelopes by mentalist Ted

Anneman. He covered in great detail areas of envelope switching and second dealing and then demonstrated several tricks using those techniques. He brought several envelopes and clearly showed us how the devious use of them will be great tools.

Members Paul Miles and Frank Yee assisted with those tricks. All of us were impressed by Mr. Fisher's extensive preparation of the material and we also appreciated his professional presence when discussing this interesting subject.

Marty Gorman lectured on the subject: "Make It Your Own". He explained that he likes to take a trick and then work with it to fit his personality. Some times he combines two or

more tricks to accomplish the personalizing. Marty asked John Piercy to help him out with a card trick. After the trick was done, Marty went on to explain how he put this trick together. We appreciate Marty's creativity.

Chris Fleming immediately caught our attention with the title of his lecture, "Oh Crap, I forgot to load my pockets". He quickly explained that quite often magicians are asked at informal setting to do some magic. And quite often, the magicians do not have any props in their pockets to perform magic. Chris suggested several effects or principles to solve that dilemma. He talked about and then demonstrated a John Carney trick a paddle move

and a common table knife and paper dots. (This can be found on one of Carney's DVD's). Many homes have a set of dice around (Yatzee, etc.) and Chris showed us an easy trick using dice. He went on to another trick straight out of Michael Webber's Life Savers. The trick employs the PATEO principal and uses every day objects conveniently found just about anywhere. He pointed us to two excellent sources on The P.A.T.E.O Force. Those references are Scripting Magic II by Pete McCabe and 33 Tricks with the P.A.T.E.O. Force by Ken de Courcy. This outstanding lecture was very well received and we thank Chris for it.

Bill Pearce introduced his lecture by saying it was a tribute to David Gray that this lecture series honors the late David Gray because he started the mini-lectures many years ago. Bill performed tricks, which he said were ones that Mr. Gray would certainly appreciate.

Those were Lite-Ning Addition by Bob Hummer that was published in Fulves book "Hummer". Bill then did "Straight Prediction "by Ken De Courcy and finished with "A Mind For Money" by Tony Bartalata. He referenced Carl Fulves "Underworld" #5" courtesy of Mel Bennett. We sincerely appreciate Bill sharing his vast knowledge.






