August Meeting Round-up

The August meeting of Ring 96 featured a lecture from dynamic performer Tom Frank.

Tom opening his lecture a bit differently than most; he started with a 35 minute magic show. He had passed out a flyer with the names of the effects and a list of other interesting topics that he was willing to speak about.

His show started off with a 4 ace production. This fed into an ambitious card routine. Next was a sight gag which was a re-appearing banana trick. A clever coin manipulation became a silk and silver coin vanish and

And return. Two selected cards swapped places in an unusual way. A high speed cups and balls followed that. Next came an off beat wallet trick featuring an old prop from many years ago. Mental Photography and Linking Rings rounded out and finished the show.

Now Tom asked simply what we wanted. He would go over the effects, or he would discuss the topics we were interested in.

Tom spent a lot of time going over the cups and balls routine in step by step details.

Everyone got a detailed behind the scenes look at how to bring this classic marvel of magic to life.

Tom showed us the mental photography deck a good use

Of a stripper deck while discussing back of room sales.

He talked about how to gather a crowd while street performing and how being a "Barker" does not get as much mileage as it once did.

Important points he made:

- He videos every show he does for analysis.
- Use music in your show, it adds another dimension
- Do "back of room" sales or you are "leaving meat on the bone."

Tom ended by going over his Silk and Silver routine as well as his Banana site gag. This amazing lecture was a huge success at Ring 96.
