September Meeting Round-up

On Saturday, September 21st, Ring 96 had our most recent meeting.

The meeting was held in the nearby Firehouse community room, as our regular center is undergoing renovations and upgrades for the next three months.

The pre-meeting workshop had the Godfather of magic, Vinny Marini teaching some of his magic moves. He taught us an amazing, yet simple force, and showed off his version of "cards across." He showed us his version of "Oil and Water," which featured his own brilliant version of a false count to show cards that are not where you think they are. The workshop was well attended and thoroughly enjoyed.

President John Piercy opened the meeting with presentations of trophies from last month's stage competition. Trophies went to Paul Case, Cliff Gerstman, and John Piercy himself.

Sadly, we have three ailing members to report. Jim Greene was in the hospital for leg-related issues. Paul Miles has suffered a heart attack, and Larry "Zeezo" Campbell fell down a flight of stairs and suffered a head injury. The theme for the night was members' favorite effect but no cards.

Cliff Gerstman, our resident escape artist was first to the stage. He performed his signature effect which he believes he is the only person in the world to do. He had a volunteer wrap a big heavy chain around his wrists and lock it in place with a large padlock. After making a few observational jokes, Cliff picked the lock open using nothing but a dime held in his teeth.

John Engman was next up. He took a short piece of white rope and tied a bow. He slid each end through one loop and pulled it very tight. Then, he slid the knot off the rope. He added a second rope, this one red. John twisted the ropes together, and the white knot passed on to the red rope. He pulled the red rope and the knot dissolved, leaving a white section

on the red rope.

Marque Dunkle performed his version of the paper clips and rubber band on the dollar bill. By placing the rubber band around the dollar bill and clipping the paper clips, then pulling the fold out of the dollar, the rubber band snaps off and the paper clips go with it now on the rubber band.

Alan Hanson took the stage and did a coin trick. He showed two coins one silver and one gold. Three times he put one coin in his pocket, only to find both had returned to his hand. While he performed the trick flawlessly, what made it great was the fairy tale story he told about a knight in shining armor and his quest to win the princess.

Wayne Mitcheltree brought out two bills, a five and a one. He folded both bills up and placed one on top of the other. Amazingly, the two bills switched places. To prove how effective this was, he repeated the effect, but this time in the hand of a volunteer. The bills still swapped places with each other.

Kevin Papke showed us a silver dollar. He proceeded to do a series of vanishes and productions making the coin move from one hand to the other and all over his body. Eventually, the silver dollar vanished for good, only to be replaced by a finger ring. The ring was no less magical than the coin had been. Keven repeatedly threaded a string through the ring, and it would pop right off. Finally, the ring appeared on his finer, only to vanish and reappear on his thumb.

Bill Pearce showed us two effects he learned at Magic Live from the Magic Circle librarian. First, he folded a dollar bill in half. He took a small piece of paper from a notepad and folded that over the dollar. He stabbed a pen between the halves of the dollar and poked it right through. Oddly he made a hole in the paper, but the dollar was still intact.

Bill continued by threading a shoelace through the handle of an old key, and demonstrating that it was not really threaded, but still free. He did this in two different ways. Then he covered the key and shoelace with a silk and showed that not the shoelace really was threaded through the handle of the key.

Brad Erickson came to the stage with a coloring book of countries of the word. He showed us all the pages, each of which showed a country and some aspect of that country to be colored. He had us all pretend to color, and the uncolored pages were now colored with colored scribbles. That was no god so he had us pretend to erase them. That worked too well and now the pages were all blank. He had us use make-believe Sharpies to restore the original artwork and that worked fine. Finally, we took another try at coloring, and the pictures were all colored again.

Then he brought up a very professional-looking, yet homemade frame that would hold six cards. He also explained that this was not a card trick as it used flashcards rather than playing cards. Each card had a picture of a different animal and its habitat listed on the front of the card. He had six cards at random put in the frame facing so we could not see what animal it was. Three cars were chosen, but no matter how we tried, the chosen card was always a cockroach.

David Fisher arrived with two scraps of paper and a pencil. He had a volunteer write a name on one, and he wrote a name on the other. Both papers were torn into little pieces. First the volunteer correctly guessed what David had written, then David correctly called out the name the volunteer had written.

Kim Hallinger was the last one of the night. She told a story about meeting a down on his luck veteran who was saluting people as they passed him on the street. Kim spoke of talking to this man and restoring some of his dignity and self-worth. While doing this she took a small American flag and vanished it in a bag. She had a frame on the table with a balloon in it. When she popped the balloon, the flag was restored, now in the frame.


















From the desk of the President


