Kozmo showed us two coin effects that used pure sleight of hand and no gimmicks. Coins moved from one hand to the other and then vanished, and he was able to

Vanish both coins somehow. Next he managed to pull one coin out of one that was already on the table, quite an amazing effect.

We saw how he set up a studio to allow him to film a street style performance for 125 people. It looked really cool.

Kozmo gave a pitch for his Reel Magic magazine. Several members agreed to its value.

He ended the lecture with a story about a lime and a lemon miscall. When he called the fruit a lemon, a woman corrected him that it was a lime. No, the lemon was under the cup.


