May Meeting Round-up

On Saturday May 20th Ring 96 met to hold its most recent monthly meeting. Lately we have been hosting premeeting ½ hour workshops to go over various moves and effects. This month we left that alone as the event was our Close-Up Competition and we did not want to risk exposing secrets to a lay audience.

The policy for our competitions is that last year's winner is the next years host. So, our treasurer Jon Strum hosted our exciting event.

John put the eight performers in order and then randomized them to make sure the event was fair to everyone. He also told the performers and audience from the beginning that he would flash a twofinger warning at the eightminute mark, hold up one finger at the nine-minute mark and then verbally call "stop" at exactly ten minutes. This again, was done to keep the playing field level each performer had up to ten minutes to present their set.

The first performer was Marty Gorman. Marty opened strongly by melting a King of Hearts through a Ten of Spades. Next, four normal playing cards turned blank one at a time. After that, the entire deck became blank. Marty showed us a deck with all the backs different and no two the same. After a little magic was added, this deck too became all blank. This time both the front and the backs were shown as being blank.

The second performer was Alan Hanson. He opened his set with a recording of the song "Tequila," but at the key moment produced a banana which he had everyone call out instead of the name of the alcoholic beverage. He continued to make bananas appear as he made puns about them. He brought out a deck of cards that had bold and



obvious numbers on the back one through fifty-two.

Volunteers chose both numbers and playing cards and found that their chosen number matched the chosen card. Alan ended his set by opening a banana and pulling out 1-dollar bills. Slowly the bills increased in value until they were million-dollar bills. He ended producing more bananas.

Jim Greene was the third performer. Jim performed his Ring-on-rope routine, in which he magically puts a borrowed ring onto a rope and takes it off again. He repeated this with two rings. A clever move was to have a volunteer hold the tow ends in front of her chest while the ring tied in was hanging down her back. Jim removed the ring from behind her. He closed with a three-ring effect creating and interesting sculpture of ring and rope.

Cliff Gerstman was number four. This made some people wonder what a stage-based escape artist was doing in the close-up competition, but Cliff held his own. Cliff opened with an inspirational sight gag on how do deal with things that block your goals in life and followed that with a large square yellow card that showed an arrow. The card was flipped over and over while Cliff told a story to go with it. There were two short card-tricks, one presented mixing up the kings' queens and jacks only to

find them in proper order after all. The other was a predictive trick as Cliff always knew what card was coming up next. He closed by teleporting a signed quarter across a close-up pad.

Club President John Piercy was the next performer. John brought out a deck of cards that were boldly lettered on the backs A-Z. He brought out dice and poker chips. After various gambling adventures and clever patter, John finally turned over several cards that had been sitting at the front the whole time and they spelled "lucky!"

Roy ball took ten cards off of the deck and He proceeded to count-spell "Will the cards match" and showed that cards had indeed found their mate. He began to deal poker hands to himself and a volunteer. Twice she beat his pair with two pair. This showed how exciting the game of poker can be.

Kevin Papke was next. Kevin started with two coins on the table and had a volunteer pick one. He took the chosen coin and vanished and had it reappeared multiple times in multiple places. Kevin borrowed the volunteer's ring and did a ring on a string effect. He managed to take the ring off the string by catching the string on her finger. Finally, he asked her three questions to see what card she would choose. She chose the three of hearts. He shoved it into the deck in a

random location, but when the cards were spread her three of hearts was right next to the three of diamonds.

In the last position was Brett
Bollich. A volunteer selected a
card and it proved to be a double
backer. This brought a huge laugh.
He had it replaced in the deck,
shuffled the deck and found the
selected card. Brett pulled a
sponge ball smile from behind the
volunteer's ear, and went into a
cup and ball routine using a
sharpie pen for a magic wand. His
kicker load was a pair of donuts.
This ending surprised nearly
everyone.

Jon's rules kept the evening moving at a comfortable pace, and the audience that was full of guests and some kids all seemed to have fun. Jon did a few effects himself as the votes and ballots were counted.

Brett Bollich won the coveted people's choice award, which is voted on by the guests and lay audience in the room. The magicians in the room voted for the other winners. When all was said and done Cliff Gerstman came in third place. Brett Bollich came in second, and Kevin Papke was this year's first place winner.


