Our first performer was Roy Ball. Roy showed us the Hunter knot named for G.W. Hunter. This is the time honored effect of can you tie a knot in a string without letting go of either end. Roy brought up a volunteer and had her tie a knot as well. The evening was off to a good start.

John Engman brought up his classic, "The egg bag." The egg appeared in an empty bag, disappeared before a spectator's eyes. John made an excellent performance out of this wonderful classic routine.

Kim Hallenger performed two routines making good use of music as she did. Kim performed both "20th century silks," and "the mutilated

parasol." It is amazing what a difference a little background music can make.

George Reis arrived on stage to demonstrate the classic effect of "the torn and restored newspaper." George used Robert Baxt's version of the effect and the audience seemed to enjoy it very much.

Alan Hanson came up wearing the chartreuse top of Captain Kirk from Star Trek. He used a temple screen to produce a phase pistol, and gave it to a young spectator along with a sticker badge making him a temporary Star Fleet ensign. Then after a long story about his engineer being kidnapped






